Cyclone Idai | 2019

Mozambique | Almost two million people had to face the devastation caused by Cyclone Idai. Galp Foundation joined up with Galp volunteers, NDGOs, Helpo and the Mozambican Red Cross to help populations affected by one of the biggest tropical storms which devastated several areas.

17,576 families received shelter, food and other goods

3,000 kg essential goods collected by volunteers in Portugal, Spain and Mozambique

6,000 polar blankets to maternal and child support actions
